✓ When you come to file your taxes bring the following:

- A Social Security card for each family member
- A valid Ohio ID
- All items listed that apply to your family
- W-2 forms for all jobs worked in 2009
- All 1099 forms for other income, if any
- Child care provider name, address, tax ID number or Social Security number
- Any other tax-related documents you have received
- Voided bank check for automatic deposit
- A copy of last year's return
- All adults on your return need to be present to sign forms
- Correct amount of stimulus payment (if applicable)

### Earned Income Credit (EIC)

For 2009, the maximum credit has been increased:

- \$3,043 with one qualifying child
- \$5,028 with two qualifying children
- \$5,657 with three or more qualifying children
- \$457 with no qualifying child

The earned income amounts have also increased. To be eligible for a full or partial credit, the taxpayer must have earned income of at least \$1 but less than:

- \$35,463 (\$40,463 if Married Filing Jointly) with one qualifying child
- \$40,295 (\$45,295 if Married Filing Jointly) with two qualifying children
- \$43,279 (\$48,279 if Married Filing Jointly) with three or more qualifying children
- \$13,440 (\$18,440 if Married Filing Jointly) with no qualifying child

### Investment Income

The investment income amount has been increased: Taxpayers whose investment income is more than \$3,100 cannot claim the EIC.

### Advance EIC Payments

Qualifying taxpayers can receive an increased amount of advance EIC payments (up to \$1,826) added to their pay by their employer.
